

Purpose

This short course offers instruction in the procedures of installation of adhesive anchor system which have been adopted by the American Concrete Institute and Concrete Reinforcing Institute.

The course is geared towards adhesive anchor installers employed by concrete suppliers, contractors, testing labs, government agencies, and other organizations in the concrete industry. This will also be of value to concrete construction special inspectors.

Those in attendance will be given the opportunity to take both written and performance exams that covers the vertical down and vertical up method. Those passing both the written and performance exams will receive a certificate and wallet card that recognizes them as "ACI-CRSI Adhesive Anchor Installer". Certification is valid for 5 years.

The American Concrete Institute's 2011 Building Code Requirements for Structural Concrete, which is referenced by the 2012 International Building Code, recognizes the role installation plays in proper performance of anchors and now requires certification of installers when installing adhesive anchors in specific orientations.

ACI/CRSI Adhesive Anchor Installer Course Content

ACI-CRSI defines an adhesive anchor installer as a person who has demonstrated the ability to read, comprehend, and execute instructions to properly install adhesive anchors in concrete. The Adhesive Anchor Installer must also demonstrate possession of the knowledge to properly assess ambient conditions, concrete condition, materials, equipment and tools for installing adhesive anchors and determine when it is appropriate to proceed with installation of an adhesive anchor

Testing Requirements

A score of 70% on the written exam is required to pass the ACI exam. The exam consists of 75 questions and is to be completed in 90 minutes. Failure on any subtest of the performance exam requires retest on only that part failed.

Course Options

A person may register for any of the following options: the ACI-CRSI Adhesive Anchor Installer Short Course, Full Exam, Performance Exam or Written Exam Only format, and the Workbook. The Test Only format involves no time spent on training, and is only recommended for people who have extensive field experience and have passed this test previously or simply need to renew their certification.
